

How long do the courses last?

The practical and driving assessments are carried out individually:

Driving Assessment	up to	1h:30m
Practical Skills Assessment	up to	0h:45m

Insurance

As part of the **MiDAS** driving assessment our Driver Assessor-Trainer is required by **MiDAS** to undertake a short (10 minutes) driving demonstration with commentary. It is considered most beneficial to organisations if their drivers are assessed on their own minibuses. Therefore, before ES RTP accepts drivers on a **MiDAS** course, their organisation must send written confirmation that:

- it has comprehensive "all drivers" insurance that will cover our Driver Assessor-Trainer when driving its minibus.
- it has given permission for the ES RTP Driver Assessor-Trainer to drive its minibus.

Introduction

Welcome to this leaflet giving details of **MiDAS** and **PATS** training and assessment courses run by the East Surrey Rural Transport Partnership.

What are MiDAS and PATS?

MiDAS - Minibus Driver Awareness Scheme

Includes information on the legal responsibilities of minibus drivers, passenger safety, defensive driving, health & safety awareness, accident & emergency procedures and personal safety for drivers.



Please Note: MiDAS is a voluntary standard mainly designed for car drivers who are licensed to drive minibuses but who have not taken a D1 (9-16 seat minibus) test. MiDAS is not a requirement of the Driving Standards Agency and does not convey a D1 licence entitlement. Car drivers under 70 who passed their UK car driving test before 1 January 1997 automatically have D1 entitlement. For licensing and test information go to: www.dvla.gov.uk and www.dsa.gov.uk

PATS - Passenger Assistant Training Scheme



Includes information about the role of passenger assistants as listed in the module headings on the next page.

Where are the courses held?

The courses can either be based at the Tandridge District Council Offices in Oxted or by mutual agreement they can be run at other suitable venues within Surrey.

When are the courses held?

ESRTP runs both courses on an ad-hoc basis. We normally require a minimum of 4 (up to a maximum of 12) people per course. Numbers can be made up by people from several organisations.

What courses are available?

MiDAS has 2 courses covering:

- Standard Minibuses
- Accessible Minibuses



Both courses come in 2 forms:

- Induction for new MiDAS drivers
- Refresher for existing MiDAS drivers

Refresher courses must be taken every 4 years to enable renewal of MiDAS certificates.

The first part of the Accessible course is the same as the Standard course. The second part is equivalent to PATS Modules B1 and B2 (see below).

PATS has 8 modules:

- A - The Role of the Passenger Assistant
- B1 - Passenger Awareness & Assistance
- B2 - Assisting Passengers who Travel in their Wheelchairs
- C1 - Supervising Children and Young People with Special Needs
- C2 - Working with Adults who Require Care and Supervision
- D - Emergency Aid
- E - Manual Handling

Module A is the foundation module for everyone, whilst the other modules are optional according to the needs of each organisation.

ESRTP is currently able to offer Modules A to C2.

Modules D and E are available through the **Community Transport Association** - see over.

What is the format of the courses?

Group Sessions

MiDAS and PATS courses consist of classroom sessions with Powerpoint presentations, group exercises and discussions. At the end of each session there is a Theory Assessment based on the topics covered. Each question has a choice of up to 4 possible answers, but only one answer is correct. The pass mark is 80%

Individual Assessments

All 4 variations of the MiDAS course include a Driving Assessment. All drivers should bring their driving licences (both parts if applicable) to the MiDAS course.

The Accessible Minibus MiDAS courses also include a Practical Skills Assessment involving the safe restraint of a passenger seated in a wheelchair within a minibus, as well as safe boarding and alighting procedures.



PATS Modules B1 and B2 also have Practical Skills Assessments. The one for Module B1 involves assisting people with walking difficulties, those who are partially sighted and those in wheelchairs. The one for Module B2 is the same as that for the Accessible MiDAS course (above).

Refresher Courses

Both MiDAS and PATS Refresher courses include the same main elements as the Induction courses, but the classroom sessions are shorter.

Refresher training is not required for PATS certificate renewal but is available for Modules A to B2 if required.
